Will	Ellie	be	home tomorrow?
	she	decorate	the room for the party?



Yes,	she	will decorate	the room for the party.
No,		will not / won't decorate

✓ Will Peter **visit** us next month?

✗ Will Peter **visits** us next month?

- Will Jasper **walk / walks** Max tomorrow? No, he won't.
- Will Dad **join / joins** the cooking competition next year? Yes, he will.
