To-infinitives 1

I'd like to be a vet. I want to take care of sick animals.



I want to be a pet. Pets don't need to do homework or study. They just eat and play. What a wonderful job!

We use **to-infinitives** after '**would like**' to talk about things we want to do in a polite way.

He	would like	to be	a football player.
They		to try	different jobs.

Would	you	like	to be	a designer?
			to take	the drawing lessons?

Grammar Tip

The short form for 'I would like' is 'I'd like'. Also, we use gerunds after 'like' but to-infinitives after 'would like'.

To-infinitives 1



We use **to-infinitives** after the verbs **'want'** and **'need'**. We use **'want'** to talk about what we wish to do. We use **'need'** to talk about what we have to do.

The girls	want	to become	famous.
Ellie	wants	to be	a pastry chef.

They	need	to improve	their writing skills.
She	needs	to practise	baking.

Grammar Tip

We put 'do not / don't' or 'does not / doesn't' before 'want' and 'need' to form negative sentences.



Common Errors

- ✓ She **needs** to work hard.
- ✗ She **need** to works hard.

- ✓ He **would like** to have tea.
- ✗ He **woulds like** to have tea.

- Ellie **want / wants** to make a delicious apple pie.
- Jerry **would / woulds** like to be an actor. Actors **need / needs** to perform plays on stage.
