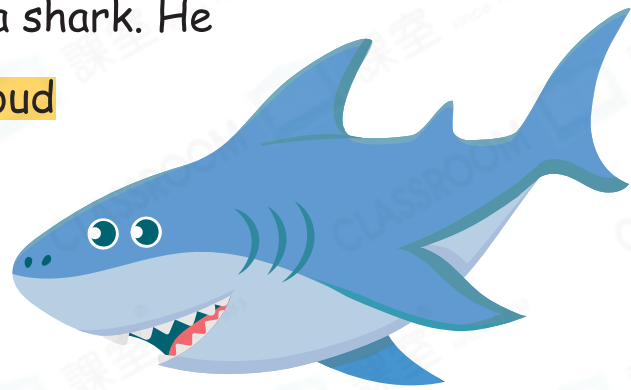




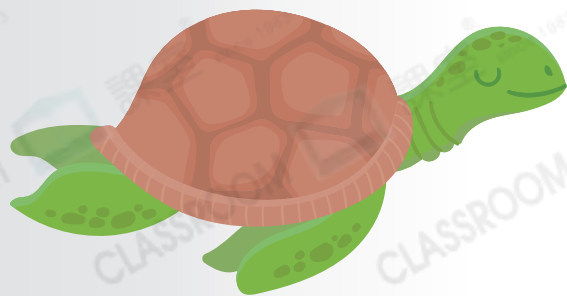
Eric is reading a fable from *New Aesop's Fables*. Read the fable.
