This research aimed to find out the number of hours secondary students spend weekly on watching TV and its effect on studies of students.

A total of 120 secondary students were interviewed, of which 60 were male and 60 were female. They were expected (1) _____ (answer) all questions in the questionnaire. When they were asked (2) _____ (recall) the number of hours they spend on watching TV on a school day, about two-thirds of the male students and half of the female students remembered (3) _____ (view) TV for more than 2 hours on a school day. A majority of them explained that was because they were not allowed (4) _____ (have) other entertainment on school days. The result showed that among these students, over 90% of them keep on (5) _____ (watch) TV programmes for more than 2 hours on Saturdays and Sundays respectively, and over a quarter actually watched TV for more than 8 hours on weekends.
