## Falling Tree Kills Pregnant Mother

### Survey report on teenagers' spending habits

A survey on how teenagers spend their money was carried out

(1) \_\_\_\_\_ New Youth Centre from 15 July to 15 August this year. 743 teenagers aged between 12 and 18 (2) \_\_\_\_\_.

Among them, 52% were female and 48% were male.



#### Findings
