I am sending you a **gift** from Hawaii. It is a **beautiful** picture frame made of seashell. I hope you'll like it.

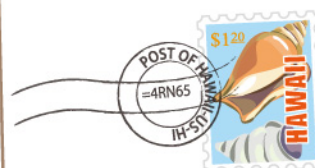


Write about your **expectation**⁶.
