### Do you know?

An aeroplane travels along the runway before it takes off. It **accelerates**<sup>7</sup> forward to **generate**<sup>8</sup> a **force**<sup>9</sup> called **Lift**<sup>10</sup>. When Lift is greater than **Weight**<sup>11</sup>, the aeroplane can fly.
