Part A

Task 1 (p.16)

Announcer : Part A. Situation.

You are Chris Wong, a Secondary 1 student. You are a member of the Environment Club at your school. You and your club members are going to organise an event about protecting the environment.

You will have a total of two tasks to do. Follow the instructions in the Question-Answer Book and on the recording to complete the tasks. You have two minutes to familiarise yourself with Tasks 1 and 2 before the recording begins.

Task 1.

You are talking with Janice, another member of the Environment Club, about the Beach Clean-up Day. Listen to the conversation and complete the notes below.

You now have 30 seconds to study the task. At the end of the task, you will have 30 seconds to tidy up your answers.

- Chris : Hi, Janice. Let's discuss the details about the Beach Clean-up Day. Let's choose a beach first.
- Janice : OK. In our last meeting, some members suggested holding the next clean-up near Sai Kung.
- Chris : Near Sai Kung. ^① How about Clear Water Bay? It's quite a popular beach among the residents there.
- Janice : Sounds good. How about the date and time?

- Chris : I suggest a Saturday in March, in the morning.
- Janice : Hmm, a Saturday in March... ^② how about the 22nd? That's after our test week. ^③ And the time... well, shall we say, 10 am to 12 noon?
- Chris : That sounds good. Which forms shall we invite this time?
- Janice : ^④ Shall we invite the S.1 and S.2 students this time? S.3 students were involved in the clean-up last time.
- Chris : That's a good idea. Now that we have agreed on the place, time, and participants, what else do we need to decide about?
- Janice : ^⑤ We need to propose our idea to our advisor, Miss Fung.
- Chris : Yes, let's tell Miss Fung about our suggestion. ^⑥ And we can make a poster to inform our schoolmates about the event. Just a minute, how do we get to Clear Water Bay?
- Janice : ^⑦ Let's book a coach. It is more convenient.
- Chris : I agree. What do we need to buy?
- Janice : ^⑧ I think we need to buy plastic bags and ^⑨ work gloves. ^⑩ Most importantly, we need to bring a first-aid kit. Remember a student got hurt last time?
- Chris : Yes, we must remember to bring a first-aid kit. Anything else?
- Janice : ^⑪ Should we draw a map of the beach for the S.1 and S.2 students?
- Chris : Yes, I'll do that. Thanks for reminding me, Janice.
- Janice : No problem.
- Announcer : This is the end of Task 1. You now have 30 seconds to tidy up your answers.

Task 2 (p.17)

Announcer : Task 2.

You are drawing a map for the Beach Clean-up Day. Listen to the conversation and label the map below by writing the letters (A-H) in the boxes provided.

You now have 30 seconds to study the task. At the end of the task, you will have 30 seconds to tidy up your answers.

Janice : Hi, Chris. Is that the map of the beach for the beach clean-up?

Chris : Yes. I'm going to label it so our schoolmates have an idea of what the beach is like.

Janice : Good idea. I know we're meeting at the food stalls. Where are those?

Chris : ^⑦ First, we enter through the gate, which is off Long Beach Road. ^⑤ The food stalls are the first building on the right.

Janice : Oh, that's easy. And what's the building next to the food stalls?

Chris : ^④ Those are the toilets and showers. ^③ This other building, the one at the top on the right hand side of the map is the rubbish collection point.

Janice : So that's where we'll dump our rubbish when we're done, right?

Chris : Yes, we'll dump our rubbish there. ^⑧ We'll start the beach clean-up at the pier, which is at the bottom on the left hand side of the map.

Janice : You mean this small rectangle that is beside the water?

Chris : That's right. ^⑥ Then we'll walk up the beach, past the stairs, all the way to the barbecue area.

Janice : ^② Is the barbecue this place here at the top with the black spots?

Chris : Yes.

Janice : ^① And what's that next to the barbecue area?

Chris : Oh, that's the lookout point. People say you can see Chinese white dolphins from there.

Janice : That's fantastic!

Announcer : This is the end of Task 2. You now have 30 seconds to tidy up your answers.

Part B (pp.18-19)

Announcer : Part B. Situation.

You are Peter Kwok, a Secondary 1 student at Kowloon Hilltop Secondary School. You are the Chairperson of the Nature Club. You have just finished organising the Beach Clean-up Day and are planning to organise the next one.

You will listen to a conversation between you and your teacher, Miss Wong. As you listen, you can make notes on page 1 of the Data File.

Follow the instructions in the Question-Answer Book and on the recording to complete the tasks. You will find all the information you need in the Question-Answer Book, the Data File and on the recording.

You now have five minutes to study the tasks and the Data File.

The conversation will begin now.

Miss Wong : Hi Peter, I am Miss Wong. I'll be going to the next beach clean-up. I heard from Miss Lam that there was an accident at the last beach clean-up. Can you tell me about the accident?

Peter : ^{T3②} OK. The injured student was from Class 1C. His name is James Chan.

Miss Wong : James Chan from Class 1C. ^{T3⑤} His class teacher is Mr Hung, right?

Peter : Yes, Mr Hung had to call James' parents about the accident.

Miss Wong : They must have been very worried about him. So how did he get injured?

Peter ^{T3⑨} : While he was walking along the beach, he tripped over a car tire buried in the sand and ^{T3⑩} fell on a rock.

Miss Wong : That was terrible. ^{T3⑦} What time did he get hurt?

Peter : Around 11:15 am.

Miss Wong : How serious was the injury?

Peter : We couldn't tell. But James was sent to hospital.

Miss Wong : Hmm, we have to remind students to be very careful and watch out for buried objects in the sand when doing the clean-up.

Peter : Yes. I will send an email to tell students about this.

Miss Wong : Good. Now, can you tell me about the upcoming beach clean-up?

Peter ^{T4⑥} : Well, we're going to Deep Water Bay ^{T4⑦} Beach on the 12th of November.

Miss Wong : Deep Water Bay? That's near Stanley, right? I know there is a bus from Central that goes there directly.

Peter : Shall we ask students to meet in Central then?

Miss Wong ^{T4⑧} : Yes, let's all meet at Exchange Square in Central.

Peter : What about the meeting time?

Miss Wong ^{T4⑨} : Let's meet at 8:45 am.

Peter : Let me write that down in my notes. We will meet at 8:45 am at Exchange Square in Central.

Miss Wong : Great. See you all there.
