Training 1.2 (pp.84-89)

Announcer : Situation.

You are Terry Chan, the chairperson of the Hiking Club. Miss Tam, the teacher-in-charge, has asked you to help draft a proposal for an adventure camp.

You will listen to a conversation between you and Miss Tam. As you listen, you can make notes on the note sheet below.

The conversation will begin now.

Miss Tam : Well, Terry. I guess we need a theme for the camp. Something eye-catching and concise. What do you think?

Terry : Good idea! <sup>T①</sup> What about 'Energy'? We're going to show our energy while we are hiking, right?

Miss Tam : Haha... And the energy of working together as a team! OK, we've decided. Now, before we can decide anything else, we need to decide if we even have enough people. Mm, what do you think?

Terry : There's a lot of interest. <sup>T⑤</sup> We have around 60 members now, but only 45 of them are really active. I think half of them would go, depending on the cost and the time, of course.
